December 3, 2007 - Deadline for entries

January 2, 2008 - Notification of accepted work

January 9, 2008 - Notification of non-accepted work and return of slides/CD's

January 27, 2008 - Exhibit opening & awards presentation, 2 - 4 pm, Jr. League Gallery, Bama Theatre

February 28, 2008 - Exhibition closes. Hand-delivered works & slides/CD's must be picked up by March 7, 2008

March 3 - 7, 2008 - Shipped work & slides/CD's returned to photographers

ENTRY APPLICATION & SLIDE/CD FORMAT

Adult Division: A non-refundable fee of \$30 will be charged for three slide/CD entries. For each additional entry up to five, an extra charge will be \$5 per piece.

Junior Division: A non-refundable fee of \$20 will be charged for three slide/CD entries. For each additional entry up to five, an extra charge will be \$5 per piece.

If entrant submits slides, each slide must be labeled on the front with artist's name, title of work, size and TOP clearly indicated with an up arrow in the upper right-hand corner of the slide. All slides must be 35 mm, mounted in standard 2x2 inch cardboard or plastic mounts. Information on slides must correspond exactly with the information on the entry form. American Shutterbug (205.345.2637) is recommended for development of slides in the Tuscaloosa area, and Cameras Brookwood (800.559.6543) is recommended in the Birmingham area. Entrants may choose to submit on a CD. CDs must be labeled with the artist's name, address, and phone number, and should be labeled with a permanent marker on the top side and protected with a case or sleeve. Format must be compatible to a PC with Windows, TIF file, 72 dpi, 800 x 600 pixels maximum.

The following should be submitted together: (1) Entry fee (checks payable to Arts Council of Tuscaloosa County), (2) Slides/CD's, and (3) entry form.

ELIGIBILITY

The competition is open to Alabama residents only. All photographic media are eligible. Adult Division is 18 years or older. Junior Division is ages 12-17. All entries must be recent, original work, executed within the last year. Works chosen for the exhibit must be professionally framed under Plexiglas or glass and be ready for hanging. There will be no substitutions for accepted works. All works accepted for the exhibition must have an identification tag attached to the back of the piece. Framed work should be no larger than 32" x 32". **ANY WORKS NOT MEETING THE AFOREMENTIONED STANDARDS WILL BE SUBJECT TO ELIMINATION.**

AWARDS

Adult Division: \$500 Purchase Award for Best of Show and four \$250 Cash Awards. Winners will be invited to exhibit at Harrison Galleries in March, 2008.

Junior Division: Digital Canon Camera for Best of Show and four \$250 Cash Awards. Winners will be invited to exhibit at the Children's Hands-On Museum in March 2008.

SALES

Works will be for sale if so designated by the artist. The Arts Council charges no commission. The Council will not act as a sales agent, but will provide the collector the necessary contact with the requested artist. Be sure to list price of work, on the entry application. If the work is not for sale, indicate with NFS, but still include insurance value.

SHIPPING AND DELIVERY

Works must be shipped prepaid in sturdy reusable crates or cartons. Ship cartons to: Arts Council of Tuscaloosa, 600 Greensboro Avenue, Tuscaloosa, AL, 35401. Work may also be delivered to the Arts Council in person. Return shipment will be made according to prepaid method specified by the artist. A money order or pre-paid return postage must be included with those works that are to be shipped back.
